

5 paragraph essay outline

1. Introductory Paragraph – This should include a hook to grab the reader’s attention, background information about the topic, and your thesis statement.

2. First Body Paragraph – This should include a topic sentence that supports your thesis statement, evidence/examples to support your point of view, and an explanation of how this evidence/example ties into your main argument.

3. Second Body Paragraph – This should also include a topic sentence that supports your thesis statement as well as evidence/examples to support it and an explanation tying everything together

4. Third Body Paragraph– This should follow the same format as the first two body paragraphs with its own unique supporting points for your argument

5. Concluding Paragraph–This should restate the main idea of your essay in different words, summarize each body paragraph’s key points, and end with a thought-provoking conclusion or call-to-action for readers to take away from reading it.
