I. Introduction

A. Hook: Provide an interesting anecdote or story to grab the reader's attention

B. Background: Provide necessary context and information about the topic

C. Thesis Statement: State the essay's main point

II. Body Paragraphs

A. First Body Paragraph: Introduce a conflict or problem

B. Second Body Paragraph: Describe how the protagonist deals with the conflict/problem

C. Third Body Paragraph: Discuss any obstacles encountered in dealing with the conflict/problem

D. Fourth Body Paragraph: Explain how the protagonist ultimately resolves the conflict/problem

III. Conclusion

A. Restate the thesis statement

B. Provide a reflection on what was learned from the experience described in the essay

C. End with a memorable statement that leaves an impression on the reader
